Bylaws

1. Categories of Membership

a) FULL MEMBER

Any person shall be eligible for admission by the Management Committee as a full member of the Society.

b) CONCESSION MEMBER

Any person who holds an aged or disability Pension Concession card shall pay a lower subscription and have the same benefits as a Full Member.

c) JUNIOR MEMBER

Any person 13 to 17 years of age shall be eligible for a Junior membership at a lower subscription rate and be entitled to the same benefits as a Full Member except for any voting rights. Junior membership must be accompanied by a parent or guardian who is a Full Member of the CSSA.

d) CHILD MEMBER

Any person under 13 years of age shall be eligible for a Child membership for free and be entitled to the same benefits as an Associate Member. Child membership must be accompanied by a parent or guardian who is a Full Member of the CSSA.

e) ASSOCIATE MEMBER: A member's partner or other member of his or her household is eligible for an Associate membership and will pay a lower subscription and be entitled to the same benefits as a Full Member except for any voting rights, or receiving any Society printed or emailed material.

f) HONORARY LIFE MEMBER

Membership of the Association as an Honorary Life Member may be granted to persons who have rendered outstanding service to the Association.

- i. Honorary Life Membership shall not be granted to any member who has completed less than 10 years membership.
- ii. Nomination for Honorary Life Membership shall be made by the committee a minimum of three quarters of whom must approve.
- iii. Membership of the Association as an Honorary Life Member shall terminate:
 - if annulled by the same procedure as that by which it was granted, or
 - if the Honorary Life Member resigns his or her Life Membership in writing to the President or Secretary, or
 - upon the death of the Honorary Life Member.

g) OVERSEAS MEMBER

A member who requires any Society printed material mailed to an address outside of the Commonwealth of Australia shall pay an extra charge for postage.

h) VISITORS

A visitor may attend a general meeting three times.
